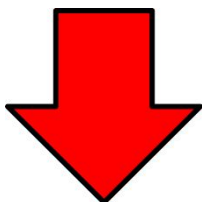
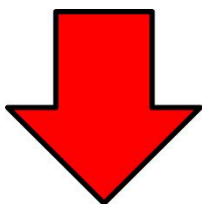


Safeguarding at Llanwern High School - for parents

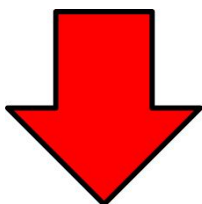
Safeguarding is the overall term for the things school does in order to ensure that all children are safe from harm.



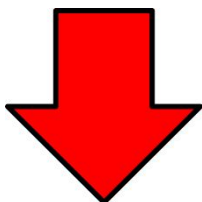
There are 4 categories of abuse identified under the term of child protection – physical, emotional, sexual abuse and neglect.



Other types of abuse: domestic violence, forced marriage, female genital mutilation, child trafficking are more examples of abuse.



If anyone in school is worried about a child in our care, then it is their duty to report it to the Designated Safeguarding Person (DSP) who will then decide if it needs referring to the Newport Safeguarding Hub.



Similarly, if **you** are worried about a child, for example, a friend of your son or daughter, then please contact the school and ask to speak to Ms E Llewellyn (DSP).
