Re: COVID-19 WELSH GOVERNMENT DIRECTIVE

Following the UK Government announcement on Monday 23rd March please be assured that at present the local free school meals collection and key worker childcare hubs are continuing as planned. However in light of this latest announcement and the changing position, this will be subject to constant review.

Following the recent developments, we will not be arranging further collection of any paper resources from Llanwern High School.

Lunch collection will continue to operate **Monday to Friday between 10am and 12pm.**

The safety and well-being of staff, the families being supported, controlled entry and exit to the school and the management of large gatherings and transmission risk is ever more critical.

The following time slots apply:

- 10.00-10.20 – Alway Primary School
- 10.20-10.40 – Eveswell Primary School
- 10.40-11.00 – Milton Primary
- 11.00-11.20 – Ringland Primary
- 11.20-11.40 – Ysgol Gymraeg Casnewydd
- 11.40-12.00 – Llanwern High School Ysgol Gyfyn Gwent Iscoed

Those children from the Llanmartin estate will be able to collect from **Llanmartin Primary School** between **10am-11am** Monday to Friday.

The lunch will include a ham or cheese sandwich, chocolate snack, packet of crisps and piece of fruit.

On arrival at school site please follow the directional signs to the front of the atrium for the entry point. Once you have collected your lunches you will leave via the rear of The Atrium and be directed back to the footbridge, car park or front pedestrian entrance. The school will be closed at 12midday daily and gates will be locked immediately to allow staff to return home.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- You will be asked to use a sanitizer gel before entering The Atrium.
- We kindly ask that as few people attend to collect meals as possible from one family group i.e. one family member can collect for all the eligible children.
- **Please do not attend the school if you are a family in isolation – send a friend, relative or neighbor**
- Please do not congregate on the school site before or after your collection slot.
- This provision is for free school meals collection only and **there will be no teaching staff at school.**

KEY WORKER CHILD CARE HUBS:

The local provision for the Alway / Ringland community ward will be at **ALWAY PRIMARY SCHOOL**, Aberthaw Rd, Newport NP19 9QP. Please visit the Newport City Council website for further information on the application process.

There continue to be many questions for us all at this difficult time, and unfortunately we have no further details available at this time. As soon as we have further information we will be letting students, parents and carers know the updated position.
